Reminiscent of your mother's teat!

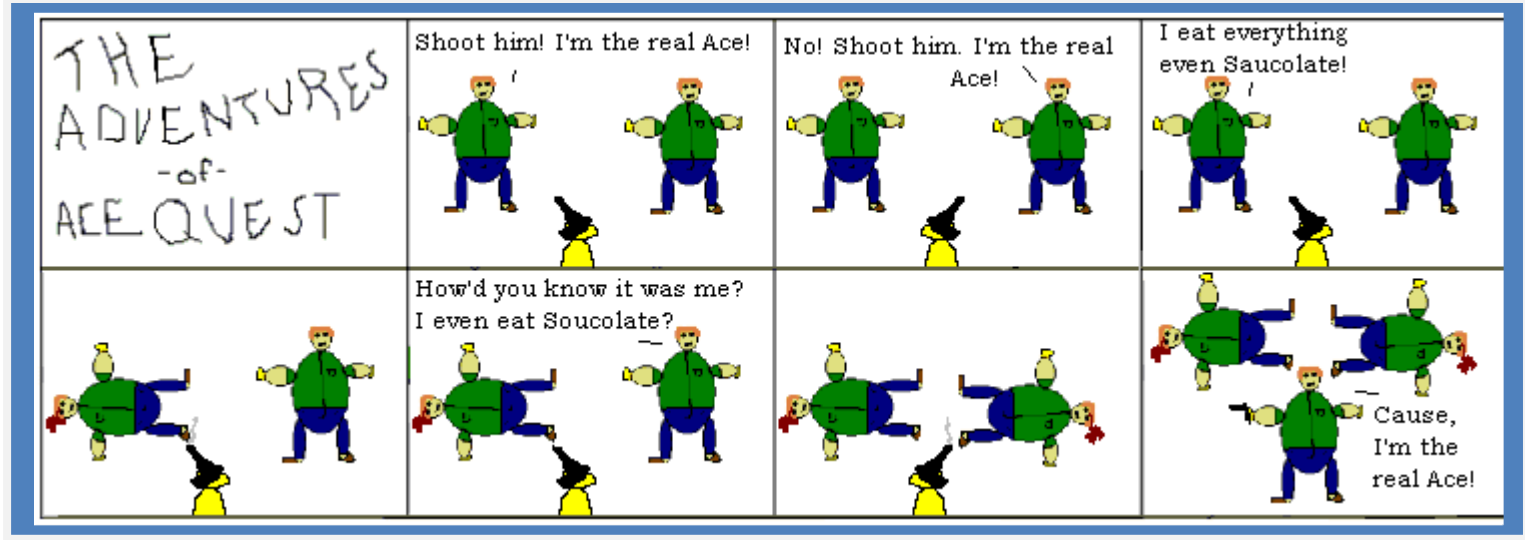

Character Sprite Artist - Create sprites for the characters in Ace Quest.

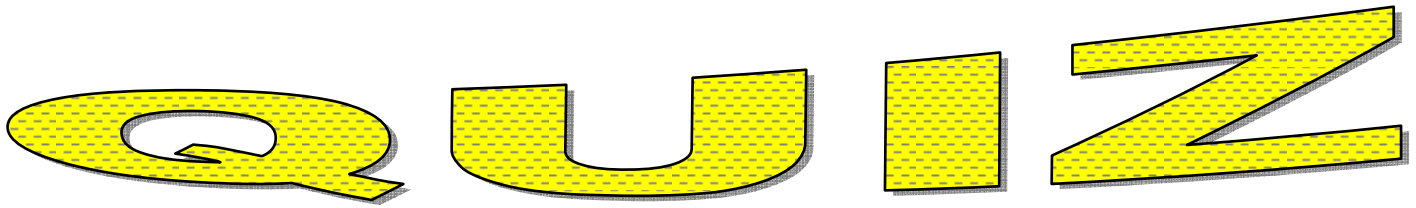
Future Available Positions

Question 4: The desert can be seen for miles and miles, and your canteen just ran out. Where do you find water?

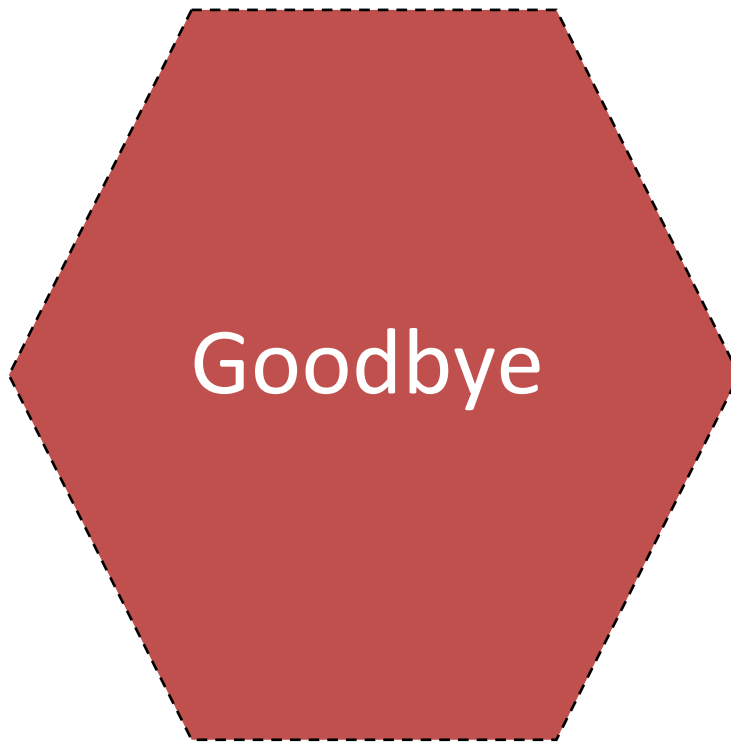
- A. I use my machete to open up the cacti I find, and very carefully use the water to refill my canteen.
